RE: Senior Rent Protections

With the passage of the Right to Counsel, low-income residents facing eviction can now be provided legal representation. While there is still a way to go, there are still unprotected classes such as our seniors when it comes to dealing with landlords and some of the exuberant fees associated with renting in the City.

Please provide a legal opinion on the following questions concerning Senior Rent Protections:

- 1) Are there any rent protections laws in place for seniors?
- 2) Are there any municipalities that have passed laws that protect seniors?
- 3) Residents have stated that developers promised that their current rent would not increase. Is there a way to guarantee these promises?
- 4) Is there a way to regulate application fees for seniors to account for their modified income and to ensure they are not predatorial? If not, what are ways we can limit application fees?
