RE: Neighborhood Enterprise Zone Certificate Application for the construction of a new single-family house at 2983 Rosa Parks in the Briggs Neighborhood Enterprise Zone area (RECOMMEND APPROVAL)

The office of the City Clerk forwarded to the City Planning Commission (CPC) an application requesting a 15-year Neighborhood Enterprise Zone (NEZ) certificate for the construction of a single-family house at 2983 Rosa Parks.

The petitioner is Alex McGillis who plans to build and reside in the house. The property is vacant land on the west side of Rosa Parks between Elm and Temple Streets – see map below.

The applicant is proposing to build a single-family house containing 2,600 square feet with 3 bedrooms, 3 bathrooms, and a basement. The estimated project cost is \$505,000. Plans for the house are shown below.

The subject property has been confirmed as being within the boundaries of the Briggs NEZ, which was established by City Council on February 17, 2004, and should be eligible for the NEZ certificate under the State NEZ Act (Act 147 of 1992) as currently written.

The NEZ Act (Act 147 of 1992) states the application for the certificate must be filed before a building permit is issued. However, the NEZ Act allows a certificate to be filed not later than 6 months following the date the building permit is issued provided the local government allows by resolution. The petitioner indicates he has not yet applied for a building permit, and the certificate was applied for on May 9, 2023.

CPC staff has reviewed the application and recommends approval. Attached is a resolution for Your consideration. Please contact our office should you have any questions.



Resolution
