WHEREAS, Den-Man and Mr. Holman has appealed the interim suspension pursuant to the provisions set forth in the Debarment Ordinance, Section 17-5-361. **NOW THEREFORE BE IT**

RESOLVED, After providing an opportunity for both Den-Man, Mr. Holman and the OIG to present their arguments, the Detroit City Council hereby finds that the OIG has not abused its discretion in entering a 90-day interim suspension against the respondents.
