Benson: Resolved, That a public hearing will be held by this body in the **City Council Committee of the Whole Room, 13th Floor, Coleman A. Young Municipal Center** for the purpose of considering the advisability of the foregoing amends A proposed Emergency Ordinance to amend Chapter 29, *Minors*, Article III, *Regulation of Minors in Public Places and Adult Responsibility for Violations*, Division 2, Curfew, of the 2019 Detroit City Code by adding Sections 29-3-14 and 29-3-15 to provide for a superseding curfew for all minors beginning at 8:00 p.m. on Monday, June 26 2023 (being the scheduled date for the Detroit Annual Fireworks Display, or any rescheduled date) and continuing until 6:00 a.m. the following morning, applicable only in the area within and bounded by the Detroit River, Third Street, the Lodge Freeway (M-10), the Fisher Freeway (I-75), the extension of the Fisher Freeway (I- 75) easterly to Gratiot Avenue, Gratiot Avenue, Vernor Highway, Chene Street, Atwater Street, and the Aretha Franklin Amphitheater.. **INTRODUCE**
