Re: 2023-2024 Homelessness Solutions Program/ ESG and CDBG Funds Subrecipient Agreements

Honorable City Council:

On February 1, 2023, the City of Detroit ("City"), acting through its Housing and Revitalization Department ("HRD"), issued that certain ESG / CDBG 2023-2024 - Notice of Funding Availability ("Homelessness Solutions NOFA"). Through the Homelessness Solutions NOFA, HRD sought proposals from eligible organizations to subgrant Emergency Solutions Grant ("ESG") and Community Development Block Grant ("CDBG") funds to help address the urgent needs of residents who are homeless or at imminent risk of homelessness. Eligible organizations must demonstrate experience and capacity to assist in one or more of the following areas:

- Street Outreach
- Emergency Shelters
- Warming Centers
- Rapid Re-Housing;
- Homelessness Prevention;
- Data Collection; and

Based on the proposals received, HRD has made twenty-five (25) Subrecipient Agreement awards to those certain eligible organizations that meet the expectations and requirements of the Homelessness Solutions NOFA. In addition, HRD is proposing two non-competitive awards. The first is for Data Collection to the Homelessness Action Network of Detroit (HAND) as they have been designated the data lead for the Detroit Continuum of Care. The second award is to fund the Coordinated Entry program, commonly known as CAM. Currently the Detroit CoC is in process of designated a new Coordinated Entry Lead Agency. Once that process is completed in the summer of 2023, HRD will seek council approval for the subrecipient agreement, as applicable.

We hereby request that your Honorable Body adopt the attached resolution that authorizes and approves the award and execution of a Homelessness Solutions NOFA Subrecipient Agreement to each of the identified organizations.
