RE: AMENDMENTS TO THE RESPONSIBLE CONTRACTOR

ORDINANCE

In our ongoing efforts to enhance the fiscal and economic integrity of the city's contracting practices, I propose the following targeted amendments to the Responsible Contractor Ordinance:

• Increase 'High Impact Construction Contracts' Threshold:

• Amend Section 17-5-1 to redefine 'High Impact Construction contracts' with an increased threshold of \$2 million, ensuring the term accurately reflects contracts of substantial economic and community significance.

• Adjust Equalization Points Allocation:

• Revise Section 17-5-12.b(4) Set the equalization points at three (3) for C-WDB and C-WIB, to prioritize labor unions, Detroit-based companies and the employment of local residents.

Maintain Fiscal Prudence in Equalization Credits:

 Modify Section 17-5-12.c(1) to retain the maximum application of equalization credits at the current \$100,000 cap, upholding our commitment to responsible fiscal management.

• Remove Additional Administrative Requirements:

• Section 17-5-13e(1) & (2) Non-major purchases and contracts require companies to submit employee income clearances, corporate accountability clearances and workforce safety clearances. Please remove the submission of these reports as a requirement to receive small contracts.

These amendments aim to strike a balance between encouraging impactful projects that contribute significantly to our city's development, supporting local businesses, supporting the labor unions that built America's middle class, and ensuring sound financial stewardship.
