

S U M M A R Y

This Ordinance amends Chapter 34 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Peddlers, Solicitors, and Vendors*, Article III, *Itinerant Vendors*, Division 2, *License*, by amending Section 34-2-28, *Expiration Date and Renewal Requirements*, to change the expiration date of licenses issued under the division to May 31st of each year.

2 **AN ORDINANCE TO AMEND** Chapter 34 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Peddlers,*
3 *Solicitors, and Vendors*, Article III, *Itinerant Vendors*, Division 2, *License*, by amending Section
4 34-3-29, *Expiration Date and Renewal Requirements*, to change the expiration date of licenses
5 issued under the division to May 31st of each year.

6 **IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT**

7 **THAT:**

8 **Section 1.** Chapter 34 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Itinerant Vendors*, Article III,
9 Division 2, be amended by amending Section 34-3-29, to read as follows:

10 **CHAPTER 34. PEDDLERS, SOLICITORS, AND VENDORS**

11 **ARTICLE III. ITINERANT VENDORS**

12 **Sec. 34-3-29. Expiration Date and Renewal Requirements.**

13 (a) A license that is issued under this division shall expire on ~~April 30th~~ May 31st of
14 each year.

15 (b) A business license that is issued under this division shall remain valid until the
16 expiration date unless suspended or revoked in accordance with Chapter 28 of this Code, *Licenses*.

17 (c) A business license that is issued under this division may be renewed only by
18 submitting a completed application and paying the required fee as provided for in this division.

19 (d) All applications for renewal of a license that is issued under this division shall be
20 filed before ~~May 1st~~ June 1st of each year.

21 **Section 2.** This ordinance is hereby declared necessary to preserve the public peace, health,
22 safety, and welfare of the People of the City of Detroit.

1 **Section 3.** All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, that conflict with this ordinance are
2 repealed.

3 **Section 4.** In the event this ordinance is passed by two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council
4 Members serving, it shall be given immediate effect and become effective upon publication in
5 accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter. Where this ordinance is passed
6 by less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council Members serving, it shall become effective
7 on the thirtieth (30) day after enactment, in accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City
8 Charter.
