RE: Requesting Resolution in Support of the Enhancing Detection of Human

Trafficking Act

On February 5, 2024, the U.S. House of Representatives passed Michigan Congressman Tim Walberg's bipartisan bill, the Enhancing Detection of Human Trafficking Act. The bill establishes a basis for training and continuing education for Department of Labor employees relative to effective detection and response to human trafficking activities.

As chair of the Human and Sex Trafficking Task Force, dedicated to exploring and enacting strategies to prevent human and sex trafficking activities, and protect survivors and those at risk of victimization, Council Member Angela Whitfield-Calloway is requesting that the Legislative Policy Division draft a resolution in support of the Enhancing Detection of Human Trafficking Act.
