Honorable City Council:

Council Councilmember Benson has requested that the Law Department prepare an ordinance to amend Chapter 5 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Amusements and Entertainments*, Article VI, *Coin-Operated Games and Arcades*, by amending Section 5, Division 6, Subsection 29, *expiration date and renewal requirements*, to all arcade licenses that are issued under this division shall expire on May 31<sup>st</sup> of each year. Previously, the license expired on April 30<sup>th</sup> of each year. This ordinance was prepared in conjunction with nine other ordinances, all related to the changing of the expiration date of licensing for various businesses. A copy of the ordinance which has been approved as to form is attached for your review and consideration.

9	Article VI, Division 2, be amended by amending Section 5-6-29, to read as follows:
10	CHAPTER 5. AMUSEMENTS AND ENTERTAINMENTS
11	ARTICLE VI. COIN-OPERATED GAMES AND ARCADES
12	Sec. 5-6-29. Expiration Date and Renewal Requirements.
13	(a) A license that is issued under this division shall expire on April 30 <sup>th</sup> May 31 <sup>st</sup> of
14	each year.
15	(b) A business license that is issued under this division shall remain valid until the
16	expiration date unless suspended or revoked in accordance with Chapter 28 of this Code, Licenses.
17	(c) A business license that is issued under this division may be renewed only by
18	submitting a completed application and paying the required fee as provided for in this division.
19	(d) All applications for renewal of a license that is issued under this division shall be
20	filed before May 1st June 1st of each year.
21	Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared necessary to preserve the public peace, health,
22	safety, and welfare of the People of the City of Detroit.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, that conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 4. In the event this ordinance is passed by two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council

Members serving, it shall be given immediate effect and become effective upon publication in

accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter. Where this ordinance is passed

by less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council Members serving, it shall become effective

on the thirtieth (30) day after enactment, in accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City

8 Charter.
