We have reviewed the above-captioned lawsuit, the facts and particulars of which are set forth in a confidential attorney-client privileged memorandum that is being separately hand delivered to each member of your Honorable Body. From this review, it is our considered opinion that a settlement in the amount of **THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS AND FORTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$38,937.47)** is in the best interests of the City of Detroit.

We, therefore, request authorization to settle this matter in the amount of **THIRTY-EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY-SEVEN DOLLARS AND FORTY-SEVEN CENTS (\$38,937.47)** and that your Honorable Body authorize and direct the Finance Director to issue a draft in that amount payable to Shantia Perry and her attorney, Nicholas A.
