Dear Colleagues,

Congratulations! NACCHO is pleased to inform you that your organization has been selected to receive a scholarship to support local health department staff certification in infection control.

Your organization had multiple people apply for the scholarship, so across those individuals included in this email, you may request reimbursement for up to \$4,000 for expenses incurred between today's date and June 30, 2024. This is \$4,000 per health department not per individual, so we recommend you strategize about what materials you will use to prepare. Reimbursable costs include registration for the exam, re-certification exam costs, reference books and other study materials, practice exam costs, membership fees for the Association for Professionals in Infection Control and Epidemiology (APIC), and registration and associated travel costs for trainings or courses to prepare for the exam. Note: If those trainings or courses are conducted through a university, additional documentation will be required.

If you wish to accept this scholarship opportunity, please complete the attached Acceptance of Award form and submit it in PDF format in OpenWater by 5:00 PM ET on Friday, March 1, 2024. Accepting this opportunity entails your LHD's agreement that the specified individuals will provide feedback on the certification process and demonstrated impact of certification to NACCHO to inform future project activities supporting local health departments in healthcare infection prevention and control. If you are unable to accept the award, please let us know immediately so another site may be selected instead. Once the Acceptance of Award form is submitted, we'll share the reimbursement instructions.

Additional instructions for submitting in <u>OpenWater</u>: Using the individual who submitted the application's account, go under "My Applications" and select "Incomplete." Here, you will see the "2024 Certification in Infection Control Scholarship" as the Program and "Letters of Commitments" as the Round. This will take you to the second round of the application to submit your signed PDF letter of commitment signifying your acceptance of award on behalf of your LHD.

We also created a community on <u>NACCHO's Virtual Communities Platform</u> that we encourage you to join to discuss with other LHDs any questions or challenges that come up as you prepare for the exam, and to ask questions of NACCHO staff about the reimbursement process (and see already asked and answered questions). You will need your (free) MyNACCHO login to access the community, and once you are logged in, you can search for <u>CIC Scholarship Community</u>. Please use this <u>guide to Virtual Communities</u> that can address questions you may have.
