RE: Authorization to submit a grant application to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources for the FY 2024 Trust Fund Grant for Clark Park

The General Services Department is hereby requesting authorization from Detroit City Council to submit a grant application to the Michigan Department of Natural Resources for the FY 2024 Trust Fund Grant. The amount being sought is \$250,000.00. The State share is 50 percent or \$250,000.00 of the requested amount and there is a required cash match of 50 percent or \$250,000.00. The total project cost is \$500,000.00.

The FY 2024 Trust Fund Grant will enable the department to:

- Install a Joe Louis Greenway path through Clark Park, which will connect the park to the rest of the greenway
- Pay for site prep, a new concrete path and plazas, signage, brick walls, fencing, and tree planting
- Install electric service, lighting, tap water service, and a drinking fountain

If the application is approved, a cash match will be provided from appropriation 20507.
