RE: Implementation of 4% Wage Increase for Non-Union Uniformed Police Executives

It is the longstanding policy of the City of Detroit to pass on to non-union Police Department executive employees the wage increases and economic benefits that are received by their unionized peers and subordinate personnel. This policy enables the City to attract and retain the highest quality employees for these executive positions.

On July 1, 2024, the Detroit Police Command Officers Association, the Detroit Police Lieutenants and Sergeants Association and the Detroit Police Officers Association will receive a 4% wage increase. Therefore, we are recommending that your Honorable Body approve the attached resolution to provide for that same 4% wage increase, effective July 1, 2024, for the Non-Union Uniformed Police Executives on the attached Schedule A.
