

## **RESOLUTION SETTING HEARING**

Resolved, That a public hearing will be held by this body on \_\_\_\_\_ for the purpose of considering the advisability of adopting the foregoing Proposed To amend Chapter 31 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Offenses, Article III, Offenses against persons*, by adding, Section 31-3-5, *Prohibiting the unlawful restraint of a patron against their will; exceptions; vicarious liability; and definitions*, in order to provide for the public health, safety and welfare of the patrons of City of Detroit businesses.
