The Michigan Office of Highway Safety Planning (OHSP) has approved \$224,750 in federal funds for Highway Safety Project grant number PT-22-31, "Detroit DUI, Seat Belt and Speed Overtime Traffic Enforcement," for the grant period of October 1, 2021, through September 30, 2022.

This grant is approved with the following conditions:

6. A risk assessment questionnaire **must** be filled out by your agency as well as any sub recipient agencies associated with this grant by **October 31, 2021**. The risk assessment questionnaire will be sent to all grantees and subrecipients via email. Failure to submit the questionnaire by the deadline may result in the withholding of grant funds.
