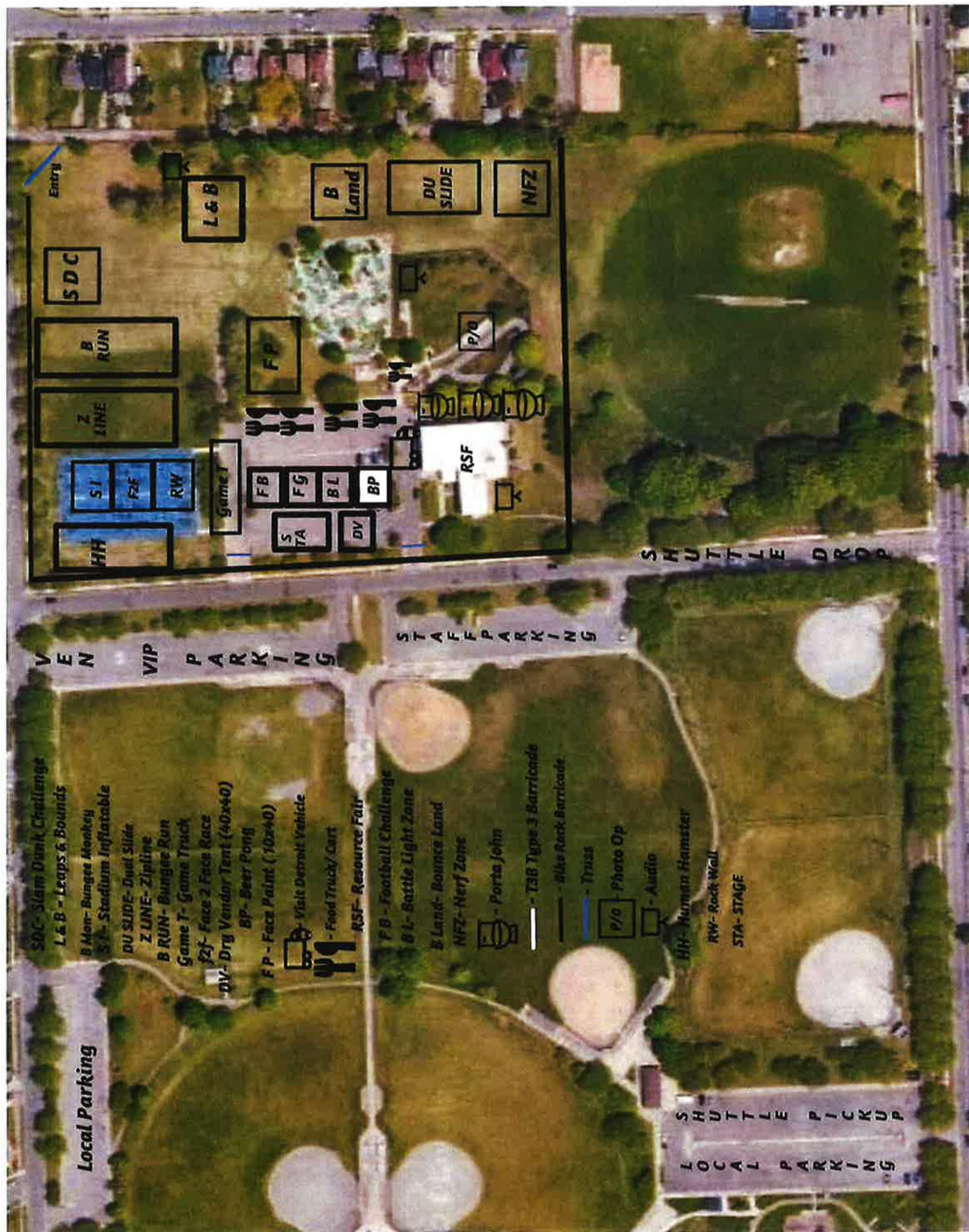

1. Event Promotion:
