
Honorable City Council:


Through the Michigan Department of Health and Human Services, the City of Detroit Housing and Revitalization Department was awarded an additional \$200,000.00 for FY 2024 Medicaid CHIP Community Development Lead Hazard Control Program Grant. This grant has been originally approved in the amount of \$1,300,000.00 and has been selected to receive an amendment of an additional \$200,000.00, resulting in a total grant award of \$1,500,000.00 for FY 2024. There is no match requirement.

The objective of the grant is to provide residential lead hazard control services to Detroit households with Medicaid-enrolled residents aged 19 years and younger. The funding will be utilized to provide outreach, lead risk assessments, lead remediation, and lead service line replacements.
