The Department of Public Works is hereby requesting authorization from Detroit City Council to submit a grant application to the Michigan Department of Environment, Great Lakes and Energy for the FY 2024 Recycling Infrastructure Grant. The amount being sought is \$1,000,000.00. The Federal share is 80 percent or \$1,000,000.00 of the requested amount and there is a required cash match of 20 percent or \$250,000.00. The total project cost is \$1,250,000.00.

The FY 2024 Recycling Infrastructure Grant will enable the department to:

- Expand the City's curbside recycling program, bringing the participation rate to 58% in the next three years.
- Purchase of 50,000 recycling carts for the City's curbside recycling program.

If the application is approved, a cash match will be provided from appropriation 26190.
