**BY COUNCIL PRESIDENT MARY SHEFFIELD AND COUNCIL MEMBER ANGELA WHITFIELD CALLOWAY**

**RESOLUTION TO RETAIN OUTSIDE COUNSEL TO PROVIDE LEGAL ANALYSIS OF THE PROPOSED SOLAR NEIGHBORHOODS INITIATIVE**

- WHEREAS,** Pursuant to Section 4-121 of the Detroit City Charter, City Council is expressly authorized to “obtain the opinion or advice of an outside law firm or outside attorney in any matter pending before it; and
- WHEREAS,** The administration has placed several items on City Council’s agenda regarding the proposed Neighborhood Solar Initiative (“Initiative”), which would involve the City’s exercise of eminent domain and which would not be in conformance with the City’s Zoning Ordinance; and
- WHEREAS,** Both the Law Department and the Legislative Policy Division (LPD) have issued privileged and confidential opinions addressing the potential legal issues surrounding the proposed Initiative; and
- WHEREAS,** The City Council has expressed the desire to obtain an independent legal analysis of the proposed Initiative from outside counsel; **NOW THEREFORE BE IT**
- RESOLVED,** The City Council authorizes its previously retained outside counsel, the Perkins Law Group, PLLC, to provide a legal opinion with regard to the various legal issues associated with the Neighborhood Solar Initiative; **NOW BE IT FINALLY**
- RESOLVED,** That the Detroit City Clerk provide a copy of this resolution to Corporation Counsel Conrad Mallett.
