

Michigan Brewers Guild – Detroit Fall Beer Festival Emergency Action Plan

I. GENERAL

The Michigan Brewers Guild Detroit Fall Beer Festival will be held Saturday, October 28, 2023 at the Detroit Eastern Market at 2934 Russell Street. Our festival is produced in cooperation with the Eastern Market Corporation, which has been a valued part of planning during the 14 years of the event's history. The festival will take place within Shed 5 and the parking lot to the north including the area under the Shed 6 canopy. The large overhead doors of Shed 5 will remain open during the event and all tents will open along the long side to allow free and easy flow of festival guests. The festival area will be enclosed with temporary chain link fence panels with exit points on all four sides. Patrons must be 21 years of age or older to be admitted to the event. Our organization contracts with a private security company to oversee a safe environment for attendees and participants.

II. PURPOSE

Because of the possibility of an emergency situation at the Detroit Fall Beer Festival, this emergency action plan outlines actions to take should the need arise during the festival. The Michigan Brewers Guild recognizes that flexibility must be exercised when implementing this plan because of the variety of potential hazards that exist for this event including Severe Weather, Medical Emergencies, Fire or situations where Law Enforcement is required.

IV. BASIC PLAN

A. Michigan Brewers Guild Representatives

Michigan Brewers Guild staff who will be responsible for the event and on site during the event include:

Additionally, we have an extensive team of volunteer staff that have been working with our organization to execute our festivals for many years.

B. Severe Weather

Weather forecasts and current conditions will be monitored prior to the event through the National Weather Service and local meteorological forecasts. If severe weather is predicted prior to the event, the conditions will be evaluated to determine if the event needs to be cancelled or postponed. If severe weather occurs during the event, event staff and security will evaluate whether attendees will need to be notified of a hazardous weather condition and potentially evacuate the site.

C. Medical Emergency

As with any outdoor event, there is a potential for injury to participants. Past experience at our festivals has resulted in very minimal injury such as minor cuts or abrasions, slip and fall or heat-related incidents. On site EMS services will be provided by Hart EMS who will treat injuries and determine if additional medical attention or transportation is needed.

D. Fire

Portable fire extinguishers will be placed in all tents and staff have been instructed on the safe use of portable fire extinguishers. for use should there be a fire. Should an incident occur that requires the Fire Department, 911 will be utilized to request this resource. Any call to 911 will include the location of the emergency, nature of the emergency and contact person with callback number.

E. Law Enforcement

Private security will address any situations involving unruly or disorderly patrons including removal if necessary. Should an incident occur that requires law enforcement, security will request this resource using 911. Any call to 911 will include the location of the emergency, nature of the emergency and contact person with callback number.

F. Emergency Vehicle Access

Access for emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times including a fire lane (minimum 20') and exits (minimum 12') on all four sides of the event space as indicated on the event Site Plan.
