- 1. Please outline the conditions and usage of the Rosa Parks Transit Center:
  - a. When does the center open to the public, and when is it closed?
  - b. Have there been any times where the center was supposed to be open, but was closed to the public? Please explain each instance.
  - c. What major repairs are needed for the Rosa Parks Transit Center?
  - d. How many buses utilize the Rosa Parks Transit Center for pickups/departures?
- 2. Please outline the current conditions of the restrooms located at the Rosa Parks Transit Center.
  - a. When are the restrooms open to the public each day? When do they close to the public?
  - b. Is there any time when the restrooms are supposed to be open to the public but are closed and why?
  - c. What is the cleaning schedule for the restrooms when they are opened to the public?
  - d. How many stalls are there in the bathrooms, and how many stalls are operational?
  - e. How many handicap accessible stalls are in the bathrooms? How many of the handicap accessible stalls are operational?
