

Brief Event Purpose & Description: Party at the Polls is an annual event held by The NAACP Detroit Branch. This event encourages voter engagement and early voting. The day begins on the NAACP Detroit property at 8220 Second Ave. In the past, the day has included music by a DJ, brief performance of Detroit's All-City Band, remarks and food trucks/vendor on our property. We also lead a march with the community from our location on Second Avenue down to the City of Detroit Dept. of Elections where attendees can turn in their ballots or complete an absentee ballot. This march has included the Detroit All-City Band, The Corvette Club, NAACP Detroit sound cars, golf carts (for photography, managing staff, videographer) and NAACP members and general members of the community. We are still working to secure commitments from the All-City Band and the Corvette Club. However, we are planning to include all of these elements in the 2024 event. Our route to the Dept. of Elections is as follows: leaving our bldg. on Second, we march down Seward to Third. We then take Third to Pallister and Pallister to W. Grand Blvd. where the Dept. of Elections sits. Participants walk back to the NAACP Detroit office or use the golf carts utilizing the sidewalks. 2 years ago, we used barricades to block streets. We also had police escorts. I worked with our NPO (3rd Precinct) to coordinate these efforts.
