## $\underline{SUMMARY}$

This ordinance amends Chapter 16 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, *Environment*, Article I, *Noise*, by amending Subdivision b, *Non-Motor Vehicle Noise*; to amend Section 16-1-13(a), *Specific prohibitions of activities constituting noise violations*; to support Detroit's Urban Cores continued growth as a world-class visitor destination by extending the hours permissible for non-motor vehicle noise.

7	IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT

9	Section 1. Chapter 16 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, Environment, Article I, Noise, by		
10	amending Subdivision B, Non-Motor Vehicle Noise; to amend Section 16-1-13(a), Specific		
11	prohibitions of activities constituting noise violations, to read as follows:

16	(a) It is unlawful to engage in, assist in, permit, continue or permit in the continuance		
17	of any of the following activities within City limits where the activity produces non-motor vehicle		
18	noise between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. with the exception of Fridays and Saturdays		
19	in the Central Business District, as defined in Section 50-16-151 of this Code, where non-motor		
20	vehicle noise will only be prohibited between the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. unless		
21	exempted by Section 16-1-14 of this Code:		
22	(1) The performance or reproduction of music through vocals, musical instrument or		
23	instruments, speakers of any type, music players, televisions, or mobile devices;		

1	(2)	The amplification or reproduction of speech through use of a microphone,
2		megaphone, bullhorn, any other sound magnification device; or

(3) The use of any steam or compressed air whistles or sirens.

- 4 (b) It is unlawful to engage in, assist in, permit, continue or permit in the continuance 5 of any of the following activities within a zoning district classified for residential use or 6 immediately adjoined by a zoning district classified for residential use where the activity produces 7 non-motor vehicle noise between the hours of 10:00 p.m. and 7:00 a.m. unless exempted 8 by Section 16-1-14 of this Code:
- 9 (1) The use of heavy construction equipment including pile drivers, jackhammers, 10 drills, or any other mechanical apparatus in building or constructions operations; or
  - (2) The loading and unloading of vehicles or storage containers.
- Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared necessary to preserve the public peace, health, safety, and welfare of the People of the City of Detroit.
- Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, that conflict with this ordinance are repealed.

Section 4. In the event this ordinance is passed by two-thirds (2/3) majority of City

2 Council Members serving, it shall be given immediate effect and become effective upon

3 publication in accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter. Where this

4 ordinance is passed by less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council Members serving, it

shall become effective on the thirtieth (30) day after enactment in accordance with Section 4-118

6 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter.
