*** SUMMARY:**

Chapter 17, Article V of the 2019 Detroit City Code requires the approval of your Honorable Body for the purchase of goods and services over the value of \$25,000, all contracts for personal services renewals or extensions of contracts, or the exercise of an option to renew or extend a contract. Under the terms of ARPA and related ARPA rules and guidance, eligible costs must be incurred through evidence of an obligation issued on or before December 31, 2024 and must be expended on or before December 31, 2026. Regulations and regulatory guidance issued by the United States Department of Treasury have provided relevant instruction and guidance for determining when ARPA Funds may be considered to be obligated.
