RE: Amendments to the sign regulations of Chapter 4 of the 2019 Detroit City Code

Please draft an ordinance amending Chapter 4 of the 2019 Detroit City Code. In collaboration with Councilmember Benson, Pro Tem is requesting the following amendments:

- 1. Allow churches and not-for-profit organizations in recreational and residential sign districts to modify, install and maintain dynamic/animated marquee, monument, and pole/pylon signs that comply with all other applicable sign regulations.
- 2. Increase the multiplier used to determine the Maximum Aggregate Signage Area (MASA) for wall signage for businesses, including tenants occupying corner or end units, located in shopping centers with four or more business tenants.
