It is with great pride that I submit for your consideration and approval my recommendation to appoint Todd Bettison as Chief of Police for the City of Detroit. As you know, Todd has served admirably as Interim Chief of Police since November.

With nearly three decades of law enforcement experience, Todd has shown himself to be a dedicated and effective leader committed to public safety, transparency, and fostering strong community relationships.

Todd's extensive tenure with the Detroit Police Department spans key leadership roles, including Inspector, Captain, Commander, Deputy Chief, Assistant Chief, and First Assistant Chief.
