RESOLVED That the Affordable Housing Task Force will be chaired by Council

President Mary Sheffield or her designee; AND BE IT FURTHER

RESOLVED That The Detroit City Council Taskforce on Homelessness and Affordable

Housing meetings are open to the public; with dates, times, and locations

to be noticed by the Detroit City Clerk.
