

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

There will be a first aid tent at the start/finish area.RF Events will hire a paramedic to staff the medical tent located in the finish line of the race. Anyone is free to drop into the medical tent for any needs. Or, paramedic can be sent to any nearby issues.

All volunteers/staff will be given a list of race day emergency numbers to call.
