We, therefore, request Your Honorable Body to authorize an Offer of Judgment; and, in the event that Plaintiffs accept the Offer, to direct the Finance Director to issue a draft in the amount of Two-Hundred Thirty-Five Thousand Dollars and Zero Cents (\$235,000.00) payable to Lamonte Jackson-Gibson and Toriel Dixon and their attorney, FIEGER, FIEGER, KENNEY & HARRINGTON to be delivered upon receipt of written notice of acceptance of an offer of judgment or, alternatively, upon receipt of properly executed Releases and Stipulation and Order of Dismissal entered in Lawsuit No.: 2:20-cv-12765, approved by the Law Department.
