## RESOLUTION COMEMORATING MARCH AS TRIPLE NEGATIVE BREAST CANCER (TNBC) AWARENESS MONTH

**WHEREAS**, Triple Negative Breast Cancer (TNBC), which accounts for 10%-15% of all breast cancers, tends to be more aggressive and have a higher risk of recurrence<sup>1</sup>; and

**WHEREAS,** TNBC is more common in younger women, Black women, and those with BRCA1 mutations, with early detection through proactive screenings critical to help victims survive <sup>2</sup>; and

**WHEREAS,** TNBC Awareness Month exists to encourage fundraising, advocacy, and education efforts to ensure that those most at-risk are aware of the resources available and the need to get regular screenings; therefore

**BE IT RESOLVED,** that the Councilmember At-Large Mary Waters and the Detroit City Council recognize March as Triple Negative Breast Cancer (TNBC) Awareness Month and calls upon all at-risk people to speak with their healthcare providers about TNBC.
