## RESOLUTION RECOGNIZING APRIL AS MATHEMATICS AND STATISTICS AWARENESS MONTH IN THE CITY OF DETROIT

**WHEREAS**, mathematics and statistics play a vital role in our society, where having a basic grasp of both is essential for children and adults to succeed in life; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Detroit has a crisis of mathematical literacy, with only 7% of 4<sup>th</sup> grade students and 4% of 8<sup>th</sup> grade students being proficient or above in math as measured by the 2024 National Assessment of Educational Progress, or NAEP, well below averages for similar cities and the state as a whole<sup>1</sup>; and

WHEREAS, Mathematics and Statistics Awareness Month is a program of the Joint Policy Board for Mathematics (JPBM)—a collaborative effort of the American Mathematical Society, the American Statistical Association, the Mathematical Association of America, and the Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics to help bring attention to the importance of mathematics and statistics as well as the crises we face as a nation in math proficiency<sup>2</sup>; now therefore be it

**RESOLVED**, the Detroit City Council recognizes the month of April 2025 as Mathematics and Statistics Awareness Month; and be it
