Overview

Bedrock aims to activate the Downtown Detroit Streetscapes this Summer through a myriad of family-friendly, fun and festive temporary installations and programming. Activations will take place from Memorial Day weekend through end of October 2025. The purpose of these efforts is to enhance visitor experiences, create playful moments for public engagement, and promote foot traffic in and around downtown businesses.

Temporary Installations & Photo Moments

We're proposing a combination of temporary interactive installations, photo moments, and temporary seating. Installations are to be placed in the locations shown on attached reference maps.

• Photo Moments

- "Be the one" photo moment Portable photo moment, consisting of the numbers "313", encouraging passersby to stand in place on the "1" to "be the one". Will be positioned at permitted programming locations, monitored by staff.
- o "Message to Detroit" photo moment Portable photo moment, consisting of a telephone booth, that allows visitors to leave a message about Detroit. Will be positioned at permitted programming locations, monitored by staff.
- "Wheel of Fun" interactive experience, encouraging passersby to spin the wheel for a fun surprise. Will be positioned at permitted programming locations, monitored by staff.
- "Fan-o-Meter" interactive experience, encouraging passerby to push the button and choose their favorite answer amongst a variety of questions such as "Who is your favorite Detroit Sports Team?". Will be positioned at permitted programming locations, monitored by staff.
- "Duo Games" interactive experience, encouraging passerby to engage with toss games using soft balls. Will be positioned at permitted programming locations, monitored by staff.
- o "Detroit Bench" photo moment stationary photo moment
- Vendor carts Utilizing 5 portable carts that will be used for free giveaways and retail sales.
- Window Display Located at 1401 Woodward Ave, this window display uses simple graphic style representing key pillars of Detroit's creative depth in architecture, music, fashion and car and street culture, in partnership with Design Core.

Temporary Installation

 Trumpet Flowers – located on 1500 block Woodward Ave, this installation concept is centered around a giant musical garden accompanied by light, color, and sound.

- Musical Minds located on 1200 block Woodward Ave, this installation concept is centered around an immersive interactive musical playground that invites participants of all ages and musical backgrounds to craft their own compositions and light displays.




WOODWARD AVENUE: SUMMER ACTIVATION FOCAL AREAS


WOODWARD AVENUE: 1500 BLOCK: SITE PLAN

WOODWARD AVENUE: 1400 BLOCK: SITE PLAN


