- WHEREAS, He honorably served in the U.S. Military. Then in 2019, was hired to join the Ceasefire Detroit team, in partnership with the Detroit Police Department (DPD), under the Detroit Youth Violence Prevention Initiative (DYVPI). He volunteers with organizations such as Focus Hope, and partners with the United States Attorney General's Office, Federal Bureau of Investigation, Drug Enforcement Administration, and local police departments to bring young violent men together to provide alternative to violence interventions and resolution. Cinceré Principle Consulting Group assists with license restoration, traffic ticket matters, child support rectification, and several other legal matters. He supports families of victims of homicide, missing people and cold cases; while also co-leading a Domestic Violence Prevention Roundtable discussion bi-weekly at Wayne County Community College District. Through this initiative, he has been able to assist and support survivors of domestic violence with personal protection orders and relocation assistance. He also teaches Michigan Gun Safety Law and gun safety classes. All of which has earned him opportunities to travel to speak at colleges and in prisons on recidivism, social resilience, and fatherhood; AND

Degree, Inc of the Universal Masonic Brotherhood. Among all these accolades,
accomplishments, and acknowledgments he is most proud of his greatest accomplishment
