## **RE:** Approval and Authorization to Accept Easement Interest in furtherance of the "Detroit Charge Ahead" Electric Vehicle Charging Station Initiative

Honorable City Council:

The "Detroit Charge Ahead" Initiative ("**Initiative**") seeks to establish publicly available electric vehicle charging stations (each, a "**Charging Station**") at privately-owned sites across the City of Detroit.

In furtherance of the Initiative, the City has negotiated and obtained from the Detroit Black Community Food Security Network ("**Owner**") a signed and notarized agreement for an easement ("**Easement**") at the Owner's property commonly referred to as the Detroit People's Food Co-Op, located at 50 East Euclid Street, Detroit, Michigan 48202 (the "EVCS Property").

This Easement is essential to the Initiative, as it will provide the City with the necessary, immediate, and ongoing authority to install, operate, and maintain a Charging Station at the privately-owned EVCS Property.

In addition, no City funds will be expended to accept this Easement at the EVCS Property.

The Planning and Development Department ("**PDD**") therefore requests this Honorable Body to adopt the attached resolution authorizing PDD's formal acceptance of the Easement.
