*** SUMMARY:**

Utilities, by adding Article IV, *Electric Vehicle Charging*, to include Section 48-4-1, *Authority*, Section 48-4-2, *Definitions*, Section 48-4-3, *Payment of costs; repayment to City*; Section 48-4-4, *Signals identifying electric vehicle charging station rates and towing notice requirements*, Section 48-4-5, *Electric power provided by DTE; electric vehicle charging station rate formula; changing rates*, Section 48-4-6, *Idling fees; grace period; maximum fee cap; waivers*, Section 48-4-7, *Establishment of kWh adder rates and idling fees*, Section 48-4-8, *Forms of designated payment; unused per session fees*, Section 48-4-9, *Vehicles impeding an electric vehicle charging station*, and Section 48-4-10, *Annual report*, to encourage the adoption of electric vehicles and provide residents with greater accessibility to clean transportation options, aligning with the City's goal of reducing transportation-related emissions and promoting a healthier environment.
