During the 1990s and early 2000s, she held DJ residencies at renowned Detroit venues such as Lush, Motor Lounge, and Buddha Lounge, and curated stages for events including Comerica's CityFest and Marshall Field's Day of Music; and

Liz Warner later moved to California, where her career continued to thrive. In 2018, she earned a Master of Arts in Specialized Journalism from the University of Southern California. While based on the West Coast, she served as a resident DJ for Dublab and hosted *Border Blaster*, an original world music video series broadcast on KCET-TV in Los Angeles. Her work was recognized by the National Arts & Entertainment Journalism Awards, the Southern California Journalism Awards, and the Los Angeles Chapter of the Society of Professional Journalists; and

Liz Warner has demonstrated remarkable versatility throughout her career. She has served as a Board Member of the Contemporary Art Institute of Detroit and contributed to a range of prominent outlets including *The Wire, Impulse Records, MTV Amp, Detroit Metro Times*, and *Orbit Magazine*. She curated a symposium of authors and musical performances at Wayne State University and cocurated a sound-only exhibition, *Sacred and Profane*, at the Detroit Artists Market; and
