SUMMARY

This Ordinance amends Chapter 29 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, Minors, Article III, Regulation of Minors in Public Places and Adult Responsibility for Violations, Division 6, Adult Responsibility, by renaming and amending Section 29-3-74 to, Parent, responsible adult, or legal guardian responsible for compliance with this article, and by amending Article VII, Parental Responsibility, Section 29-7-2, Parental violation and penalty, to help mitigate violent crime and reduce teenage gun violence.

2	THIS ORDINANCE amends Chapter 29 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, Minors, Article
3	III, Regulation of Minors in Public Places and Adult Responsibility for Violations, Division 6,

8	IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT
9	THAT:
10	Section 1. Chapter 29 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, Minors, is amended by amending
11	Article III, Division 6, Section 29-3-74 and Article VII, Section 29-7-2, to read as follows:
12	CHAPTER 29. MINORS
13	ARTICLE III. REGULATION OF MINORS IN PUBLIC SPACES
14	AND ADULT RESPONSIBILITY OF VIOLATIONS
15	DIVISION 6. ADULT RESPONSIBILITY
16	Sec. 29-3-74. Parent, responsible adult, or legal guardian responsible for compliance with
17	this article.
18	(a) It shall be unlawful for the parent, responsible adult, or legal guardian to permit a
19	minor to violate any provision of this article.
20	(b) Upon the first conviction of a violation of this article, the parent, responsible adult,
21	or legal guardian shall be subject to a fine of \$250.00.
22	(c) Upon the second or subsequent convictions of a violation of this article, the parent,
23	responsible adult, or legal guardian shall be subject to a fine of \$500.00

ARTICLE VII. PARENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

Sec. 29-7-2. Parental violation and penalty.

- (a) If a minor commits a delinquent act, the parent shall be guilty of a violation of this article if it is proven that any act, word, or nonperformance of parental duty by the parent encouraged, contributed toward, caused, or tended to cause the commission of the delinquent act by the minor.
- 7 (b) Upon the first conviction of a violation of this article, the parent shall be subject to 8 a fine of not less than \$75.00 nor more than \$100.00 \$250.00.
 - (c) Upon the second <u>or subsequent</u> convictions of a violation of this article, the parent shall be subject to a fine of <u>not-less than \$100.00</u> nor <u>more than \$500.00</u> and, in addition, be sentenced to probation upon the condition that the parent participate in, through completion, a court-approved, community-based treatment program, such as parenting skills, family services, employment and training, or, in the discretion of the court, be confined to the county jail for a period of not less than 15 days nor more than 30 days.
 - (d) Upon the third or subsequent violations, the parent shall be subject to a fine of not less than \$250.00 or more than \$500.00 and, in the discretion of the court, confinement in the county jail for a term of not less than 15 or more than 90 days or, as alternative sentencing, sentenced to probation upon the condition that the parent participate in a government-sponsored mandatory work program for the duration of the sentence.
 - (e) The formula for alternative sentencing shall be comprised of a number of days of a required sentence, provided, that the sentence to the community self help or work program shall be upon the condition that if the violator fails to comply with the rules of the designated program,

1 the sentence to the program shall be revoked and the violator shall actually serve a required jail

2 sentence.

3 Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared necessary to preserve the public peace,

4 health, safety and welfare of the People of the City of Detroit.

Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, that conflict with this ordinance are

7 Section 4. In the event this ordinance is passed by two-thirds (2/3) majority of City

8 Council Members serving, it shall be given immediate effect and become effective upon

publication in accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter. Where this

ordinance is passed by less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council Members serving, it

shall become effective on the thirtieth (30) day after enactment in accordance with Section 4-118

of the 2012 Detroit City Charter.
