RE: Request to Accept and Appropriate the FY 2023-2024 Wayne County Parks Millage Grant

Wayne County awarded the City of Detroit General Services Department with the FY 2022-2023 Wayne County Parks Millage Grant for a total of \$280,000.00. There is no match requirement. The total project cost is \$280,000.00. Detroit City Council approved the request to accept and appropriate this funding on June 13, 2023. This request is to execute a grant amendment for a time extension to the project period. Wayne County requires council authorization to execute this grant agreement amendment. The original grant end date was September 30, 2025. The grant amount will not change. If approval is granted, the grant end date will be extended to September 30, 2026.

The objective of the grant is to make improvements to various parks across the City of Detroit. The funding allotted to the department will be utilized to make various improvements to the following parks and park areas: (1) Kelley Park – dog park; (2) Eliza Howell Park – trail improvements; (3) Hardstein Park – fitness equipment or horseshoe courts; (4) Chandler Park – picnic tables and trees; (5) Three Mile-Munich – walkways; and (6) Voigt Park – landscape improvements.

I respectfully ask your approval to accept appropriate funding in accordance with the attached resolution.

WHEREAS, the General Services Department is requesting authorization to accept a time extension for a grant of reimbursement from Wayne County, awarded in the amount of \$280,000.00, to make improvements to various parks in the City of Detroit; and

WHEREAS, Detroit City Council approved the request to accept and appropriate this funding on June 13, 2023, and this request is to execute a grant amendment for a time extension to the project period; Wayne County requires council authorization to execute this grant agreement amendment; and

WHEREAS, the original grant end date was September 30, 2025; and the grant end date will be extended to September 30, 2026; and

WHEREAS, the Law Department has approved the attached agreement amendment as to form; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Director or Head of the Department is authorized to execute the grant amendment on behalf of the City of Detroit, for a time extension to the project period, for the FY 2022-2023 Wayne County Parks Millage Grant.

AMENDMENT NO. 1 TO THE AGREEMENT BETWEEN
THE COUNTY OF WAYNE AND THE CITY OF DETROIT

THIS AMENDMENT is made by and between the County of Wayne, Michigan, a body corporate and charter county acting through its Department of Public Services, Parks Division (“County”) and the City of Detroit, a Michigan municipal corporation (“City”), and modifies the intergovernmental agreement for the 2022-2023 park millage allocation for improvements to Kelley Park (District 1), Eliza Howell Park (District 1), Hardstein Park (District 2), Chandler Park (District 4), Three Mile-Munich Park (District 4) and Voigt Park (District 5), approved by the Wayne County Commission on October 5, 2023 by Resolution No. 2023-753 (“Agreement”).

WHEREAS, the parties wish to extend the Agreement term to end on September 30, 2026 (from September 30, 2025) to provide for the completion of the improvements at the above-referenced parks.

NOW, THEREFORE, it is mutually agreed by and between the parties hereto as follows:

1. The termination date described in Section 3.01 of the Agreement shall be modified from “September 30, 2025” to “September 30, 2026”.
2. All other terms and conditions in the Agreement shall remain in full force and effect.
3. This Amendment is subject to the County’s policies regarding modification of agreements.
4. Each party warrants that the person signing this Amendment is authorized to sign on behalf of its principal and is empowered to bind its principal to this Amendment.
5. This Amendment shall become part of the Agreement between the parties.
