**COACH ENGINE REPAIRS  
 COACH TRANSMISSION REPAIRS  
 COACH BODY REPAIRS**

Pursuant to Section 17-5-91 c, The Purchasing Director, without prior approval of the City Council, may make, or authorize others to make, an emergency procurement when public exigencies require the immediate delivery of articles or performance of services or when there exists a threat to public health, welfare or safety under emergency conditions where prior approval of the City Council would be impossible or impracticable under the circumstances.


The following contracts were entered into and granted by the Chief Procurement Officer, as noted below, to provide coach engine, transmission, and body repair services for the Detroit Department of Transportation revenue coaches. The emergency contracts are needed to repair coaches that are inoperable, which makes it difficult for residents to access jobs, education, healthcare, grocery stores, and other vital services, particularly impacting those who rely on public transportation due to age, disability, and low income. With less of an available fleet, that leads to unreliable transit and with the uncertainty of travel times it can significantly contribute to commuter stress and reduce overall satisfaction with commuting experience, not to mention increased safety risks for both drivers and riders. This can include the increased likelihood of accidents and delayed emergency response times.

Cummins, Inc. was selected because they are the OEM for DDOT’s coach engines. W.W. Williams was selected because they are the authorized vendor in Michigan to perform work on Allison Transmissions that are used in DDOT’s coaches. Dave’s Collision Collision was selected because of its proximity to DDOT, which reduces costs to transport the coaches to the vendor’s location. Dave’s Collision Collision also repairs coaches at an expeditious rate.

Please note that OCP is currently negotiating long-term contracts for all of the abovementioned services.
