The Michigan Department of Health and Human Services (MDHHS) has awarded the City of Detroit Health Department with the FY 2026 Emerging Threats – Hepatitis C Grant, in the amount of \$139,611.00. There is no match requirement. The grant was adopted in the FY 2026 budget in the amount of \$116,734.00. The grant was awarded at a higher amount than was budgeted. We are requesting to increase appropriation 21460, in the amount of \$22,877.00, to reflect the total project cost of \$139,611.00.

The objective of the grant is to make improvements in hepatitis C virus (HCV) testing, case follow-up, and linkage to care. The funding allotted to the department will be utilized to pay for program staff salaries, travel, and supplies.
