**Subject:** [EXTERNAL] Urgent Request for Water Quality Inspection and Lead Testing – ZIP 48235

Hi, I'm contacting you because the water at my family's home in ZIP code 48235 has been brown since November 2024, and we believe there is lead contamination. This issue began after city workers came out and did work in the area. I'm currently in college, so I didn't realize how long this had been going on, but my family should not have to live like this. They have been forced to use bottled water for cleaning and drinking, which is unacceptable and unsafe.

We need an emergency water quality inspection, free lead testing, and to be added to the list for free lead service line replacement. No one in the home should be paying for any repairs because this is a city infrastructure issue.

Please schedule someone to come out as soon as possible. If anyone tries to say this is not related or that we need to pay, please escalate this to a supervisor. This is a serious health and safety problem that has been ongoing for too long.
