Honorable Detroit City Council Members:

The City of Detroit Hazard Mitigation Plan prepared by the Office of Homeland Security & Emergency Management in collaboration with its consultant, Integrated Solutions Consulting, Inc. has met FEMA's required criteria for a single jurisdiction Hazard Mitigation Plan. FEMA's plan approval is a two-step process. The first step is to meet the required criteria.

A FEMA approved Hazard Mitigation Plan enables the city to apply for mitigation grant funding, when available. The Hazard Mitigation Plan identifies the highest ranked hazards and activities that can be undertaken by the city to reduce the threats to health, safety and property damage caused by natural hazards. It also serves as the basis for the city and State to prioritize project funding.

We respectfully request your approval of the attached resolution to adopt the updated City of Detroit Hazard Mitigation Plan, which is the final step in the FEMA approval process.
