### **Request:**

The above recommendation is at the request of the Office of the Inspector General.

## **Rationale:**

In March of 2022, the Inspector General's Office requested the Inspector General classification be evaluated to ensure its pay range was externally competitive and on par with the pay range for the Auditor General at the City of Detroit. The Auditor General pay range was increased earlier this year.

As a result of the aforementioned request, the Human Resources Classification and Compensation Division completed a market study for the Inspector General classification. The study was conducted using data from comparable municipalities. The results indicate that the Inspector General pay range is not competitive.

The proposed pay range recommendation is subject to City Council approval.
