From this review, it is our considered opinion that a settlement of the PIP claim in the amount of TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED FIFTY DOLLARS AND NO/CENTS (\$28,750.00) is in the best interest of the City of Detroit.
