*** SUMMARY:**

On March 15, 2022, Detroit City Council authorized the settlement of City of Detroit v. Women's Justice Center, et al, and the acquisition of 10401 E. Jefferson Avenue (the "Property") from the Women's Justice Center (the "Seller") for Twenty Thousand and 0/100 Dollars (\$20,000.00). Acquisition of the Property was conditioned upon the Housing and Revitalization Department's submission of this environment assessment report.
