RE: DONALD RUDD vs CITY OF DETROIT

On November 15, 2022, your Honorable Body authorized settlement of the wage loss portion of the lawsuit of Donald Rudd vs City of Detroit, Department of Transportation; File # 14670 (PSB), in the amount \$55,000.00. That payment did not address Medicare's interest (pursuant to 42 U.S.C. Sec. 1395, et seq. and rules promulgated thereunder) and the medical part of Donald Rudd's workers compensation claim was not resolved.

The Center for Medicare and Medicaid Services ("CMS") has approved a Workers Compensation Medical Set-Aside ("WCMSA") in the amount of \$7,829.00 to adequately address Medicare's interests.

We, therefore, request authorization to settle the medical part of this matter for the amount of **SEVEN THOUSAND EIGHT HUNDRED AND TWENTY-NINE DOLLARS** (\$7,829.00); and that your Honorable Body authorize and direct the Finance Director to issue drafts totaling that amount payable to Donald Rudd, to be delivered upon receipt of properly executed releases and order of dismissal in Workers Compensation Claim #14670, approved by the Law Department.
