SUMMARY

This ordinance amends Chapter 43, of the 2018 Detroit City Code, Streets, sidewalks, and other public places, by adding Article XIV, Transportation Innovation Zone, which consists of Section 43-14-1, Transporation Innovation Zone, Section 43-14-2, Innovative Technology Deployments, Section 43-14-3, Notice to City Council, to allow for temporary authorizations of deployments of innovative technologies within a designated transporation innovation zone.

7	IT IS HEREBY ORDAINED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE CITY OF DETROIT
8	THAT:
9	Section 1. Chapter 43 of the 2018 Detroit City Code, Streets, sidewalks, and other public
10	places, is amended by adding Article XIV, Transporation Innovation Zone, consisting of Sections
11	43-14-1 through 43-14-3, to read as follows:
12	CHAPTER 43. STREETS, SIDEWALKS, AND OTHER PUBLIC PLACES
13	ARTICLE XIV. TRANSPORTATION INNOVATION ZONE
14	Sec. 43-14-1. Transporation Innovation Zone.
15	The City's Chief of Mobility Innovation may designate an area around Michigan Central
16	Station at 2001 15th Street as a Transportation Innovation Zone so long as the area does not include

_,	any boundaries beyond Grand River and the Lodge Freeway (M-10) to the east, Martin Luther
18	King Jr Boulevard to the north, the Fisher Freeway (I-75) to the West, and the Detroit River to the

- Transporation Innovation Zone, including but not limited to a permit to obstruct or encumber any
 public place or right of way. As used in this section, "Innovative Technology" means any new or
- 3 emerging technology, or novel use of an existing technology, to address a local problem or
- 4 provide a local benefit in government administration, government services, nonprofit
- 5 organizations, or private enterprise.

- (2) The following applies to a permit, license, or authorization temporarily issued under
 this section:
- (a) The Chief of Mobility Innovation may attach conditions, parameters, and fees to the
 approval.
- (b) Any act, use, or event allowed by the permit, license, or authorization shall primarily
 take place within the Transportation Innovation Zone.
- 12 (c) The permit, license, or authorization may be issued for a period of up to 180 days and
 13 may be renewed once by the Chief of Mobility Innovation for up to an additional 180
 14 days. City Council may extend the permit, license, or authorization beyond the renewal
 15 period at the request of the Chief of Mobility Innovation.
- (d) The permit, license, or authorization is not transferable to another person or location.
 (e) The Chief of Mobility Innovation, in consultation with a department director or
 agency head that may otherwise issue the approval, shall apply any regulation or
 provision of this Code related to that permit, license, or authorization that he or she
 determines is necessary to protect the health, safety, or general welfare of the public.
 - (f) The Chief of Mobility Innovation may immediately suspend or revoke the permit, license, or authorization in order to protect the health, safety, or general welfare of the public.

1	(g) The Chief of Mobility Innovation may direct the appropriate department or agency to
2	take enforcement action against the recipient of the permit, license, or authorization.
3	(3) This section does not preclude the issuance of a permit, license, or authorization under
4	any other provision of this Code.
5	(4) An application for a permit, license, or authorization under this section shall be
6	submitted on a form and in a manner approved by the Office of Mobility Innovation.
7	Sec. 43-14-3. Notice to City Council.
8	Within five days of taking any of the following actions, the Office of Mobility Innovation
9	shall provide notice of the same to City Council:
10	(a) <u>Designating or revising the boundaries of the Transporation Innovation Zone.</u>
11	(b) <u>Issuing or renewing any permit, license, or authorization issued under this Article.</u>
12	(c) Suspending or revoking any permit, license, or authorization issued under this Article.

14	Section 2. This ordinance is hereby declared necessary to preserve the public peace,
15	health, safety and welfare of the People of the City of Detroit.
16	Section 3. All ordinances, or parts of ordinances, that conflict with this ordinance are
17	repealed.
18	Section 4. In the event this ordinance is passed by two-thirds (2/3) majority of City
19	Council Members serving, it shall be given immediate effect and become effective upon
20	publication in accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter. Where this
21	ordinance is passed by less than a two-thirds (2/3) majority of City Council Members serving, it
22	shall become effective on the thirtieth (30) day after enactment, or on the first business day

thereafter, in accordance with Section 4-118 of the 2012 Detroit City Charter.
