TAKEN FROM THE TABLE

Council Member Durhal moved to take from the table a Proposed Ordinance To amend Chapter 18 of the 2019 Detroit City Code, Fire Prevention and Protection, by amending Article I, Detroit Fire Prevention and Protection Guide, by renaming Division 10, from "Storage of Scrap Tires in Outdoor Collection Sites" to "Storage of Scrap Tires in Indoor and Outdoor Collection Sites," by amending Section 18-1-181, Definitions, Section 18-1-183, Unauthorized storage of scrap tires in outdoor collection sites prohibited, Section 18-1-185, Permit requirement, and Section 18-1-194, Fence requirements, and by renaming and amending Section 18-1-188, from "Stacking requirements" to "Stacking and storage requirements" to model state law in the regulation of storage of less than 500 scrap tires in outdoor collection sites, to bring the City Code into compliance with state law, and other technical amendments (SIX (6) VOTES REQUIRED AND SHALL BE GIVEN IMMEDIATE EFFECT AND SHALL BECOME EFFECTIVE UPON PUBLICATION) ROLL CALL

The Ordinance was then placed on the order of third reading.

THIRD READING OF ORDINANCE.

The title to the Ordinance was read a third time.

The ordinance was then read.

The question being "Shall this Ordinance Now Pass?"

The Ordinance was passed, a majority of the Council Members present voting therefore as follows:
