- WHEREAS: Reverend Dr. James C. Perkins, believing that the church has a responsibility to serve both the temporal, as well as the spiritual needs of the surrounding community, established numerous enterprises that support that vision. In 1992, he founded the Fellowship Nonprofit Housing Corporation, as a vehicle for community economic development, creating the \$10 Million Providence Place which provides 50 single family homes for low-and middle-income families; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Dr. James C. Perkins, recognizing the educational crisis facing young, urban, African American males, instituted the Benjamin E. Mays Male Academy in 1993, a kindergarten through sixth grade Christian school for boys, that has positively impacted the future of hundreds of males; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Dr. James C. Perkins is the author of "Building Up Zion's Walls: Ministry for Empowering the African American Family", "Playbook for Christian Manhood:12 Key Plays for Black Teen Boys", "Midnight Religion: Messages of Victory in the Midst of Adversity" and "Staking Claim to Your Mountain: Sermons of Empowerment and Endurance". His other writings have been included in both secular and Christian publications such as Black Enterprise, USA Today, Ebony, American Baptist, The African American Pulpit and the bestselling book, "Success Runs in Our Race" by George Fraser; and
- WHEREAS: Reverend Dr. James C. Perkins currently serves on the NAACP's National Board of Directors. He has been an adjunct professor at the Interdenominational Theological Center (ITC), Atlanta GA, and a former trustee at Wiley College, Marshall, TX. Reverend Dr. James C. Perkins has served as past president of the Michigan Progressive Baptist Convention. He is a member of the Council of Baptist Pastors of Detroit and Vicinity, a member of the Detroit Chapter of the NAACP and is a Life Member of Kappa Alpha Psi Fraternity, Inc..
