**RE:** Requesting an Opinion on Right to Renew Ordinance

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### SUMMARY:

In October 2022, the Ann Arbor City Council passed an ordinance that requires local landlords to offer their tenants a lease renewal 180 days prior to their lease end date. This ordinance prohibits landlords from denying a renewal without just cause. If landlords do not comply with this ordinance, they can be responsible for paying tenants' relocation fees.

As Detroit is a majority renter city with above-average eviction filing rates, I am requesting that the Law Department opine on the legality of a Right to Renew ordinance in Detroit. Detroit Tenants' Association has formulated a Right to Renew proposal which is attached for reference. Also attached is Ann Arbor's Right to Renew Ordinance is attached.
